## Overseas Samoans to vote in General Elections?

**C**ontrary to renewed calls to allow Samoans residing overseas to vote in General Elections, government under no circumstance is stopping any Samoan eligible to vote to be part of the democratic election process, says Prime Minister Tuilaepa Lupesoliai Sailele Malielegaoi.

Opening the electoral rolls for overseas Samoans to cast their ballots as absentee voters during general elections has resurfaced again

with Former Prime Minister and Ex-Opposition Leader Tui Atua Tupua Tamasese Efi urging Government to amend the electoral laws to this effect.

But the Prime Minister is baffled with the narrow minded thinking by the former PM.

"Lest Tupua forgets, this has been a long standing issue which has been duly addressed by Parliament with amendments to the Electoral Act based on recommendations from Commission of Inquiries established law after every General Elections," responded the Prime Minister.

"And among those amendments ensures the right for all Samoan eligible to vote to exercise that right without restraints," said Tuilaepa.

"One mandate approved by Parliament is for all Samoans to satisfy the three year residency requirement to be eligible to vote or run as an election candidate.

"The second is for all election candidates to serve his constituency

On this very special day, I greet you in the mighty Name of Jesus Christ. Fifty eight years ago, our country came together in accord, and with so much happiness to celebrate our first independence. Today, we pause to give God the glory and the praises, for His endless grace that has kept our country to survive the torrents of stormy seas and turbulences, over these many years of our independence.

The unprecedented spread of the pandemic, COVID 19 around the world, has subsequently led to readjustments in the way we operate our duties and responsibilities. We are at abnormal times as we continue to fortify our collective efforts to keep the COVID 19 at bay. As such, this is the first time since the genesis of our independence celebrations that the official programme for this year's 58th independence celebration is being communicated through television and radios stations, and the Internet.

We welcome our 58th Independence anniversary with the guiding verse of our national anthem, 'Samoa tulai, ma sisi ia lau fu'a, o lou pale lea, vaai ina fetu o loo ua agiagia mai, o le faailoga lea ua mafai na e tautai', which translates 'Samoa let us arise to raise our flag, our crown; see the stars flying therein, symbolising our ability to govern'. # PM denounces “irresponsible and reckless rumours”

Rumours that some of the Samoan passengers who arrived last Friday from Auckland on the repatriation flight are suspected to have COVID-19 symptoms, have been labelled as “irresponsible and reckless,” by Prime Minister Tuilaepa Sailele Malielegaoi.

Denouncing the rumours during his Taimi ole Palemia weekly television program with TV1 last night, Tuilaepa reassured that country that he was informed late yesterday that the said rumours are lies created to cause unnecessary panic.

“There will always be people resorting to deceit and lies to defame and discredit the Government and the tarnish the work by dedicated and professional public servants,” elaborated Tuilaepa. “It’s natural for these devious minds to undermine any and all of Government’s positive achievements to suit their ulterior motives.

“And to clear any doubts I have been informed by the Health CEO that initial tests after the passengers arrived have cleared all of the returning residents of any suspected symptoms,” he continued. All the necessary precautions which include daily medical check-ups for the returning residents are continuing until the 14 quarantine mandate is satisfied.”

He added that the Ministry of Health facilitated by the National Emergency Operation Center, (N.E.O.C.) continues to remain on the frontline protecting Samoa’s borders from COVID 19.

“We are as ready as we can be,” reassured Tuilaepa. “Protecting all residents from the virus remains paramount to Government.”

On a separate note, the Prime Minister also acknowledges the spiritual support from prayers by all churches and denominations which he says is

the divine intervention that continues to protect Samoa from COVID 19.

On the global front, the Prime Minister noted that latest reports shows that while the pandemic appears to be slowing down, it is no excuse for Government to relax.

“There remains the chance for the virus to reach Samoa and that is the last thing we want,”

he said noting that as of yesterday and based on NEOC reports, COVID 19 has claimed close to 380 thousand lives with the United States accounting for over 100-thousand fatalities or one third of the lives lost.

While there are fatalities in Australia (103 as of yesterday) and New Zealand (22 as of yesterday), the report noted the high recovery cases in both countries with no seriously critical case in New Zealand and only 3 in Australia.

“We continue to monitor the developments on

a daily basis and we will continue to change our State of Emergency Orders as Government sees fit. These decisions are made all in the best interest of protecting the country from COVID-19,” he said.

In his ending remarks, he reiterated earlier calls by Health and NEOC officials not to be easily convinced with the unofficial reports and fake news littering the viral media and to seek the factual information circulated and posted on the Ministry of Health and Government of Samoa’s website and official government outlets.

# VAGST's factual history recorded in Hansard, clarifies PM Tuilaepa

The VAGST tax is the product of the Off-Shore Banking (principal) Act initiated by then Prime Minister, the late Vaai Kolone and his Deputy PM Tupua Tamasese Efi and approved into law by Parliament.

"It's all in the Hansard, (Legislature's Official Records)," clarifies Prime Minister Tuilaepa Sailele Malielegaoi.

Also in the Hansard added the Prime Minister is a speech by then Minister of Finance, Faaso'otaua Sam Saili which acknowledges the beginning of the VAGST with a tax on hotels with the intention to extend it across the board that will also include a VAGST on services. "It can't be memory loss

Tui Atua had claimed that the VAGST tax which was severely opposed by the Pule and Tumua public movement was authored by then Prime Minister Tofilau Eti Alesana and then Finance Minister Tuilaepa. That act, insisted Tui Atua was approved by Parliament in 1993 under the Tofilau Eti Administration.

Not so, refuted Prime Minister Tuilaepa noting that when appointed by PM Tofilau as Finance Minister, he took over VASGT from where Tupua's administration left it and it included amendments to the Principal Off Shore Banking Act passed by



Parliament during Tupua's tenure.

Tuilaepa says that it was also predictable when Tupua orchestrated the Pule and Tumua Movement to stir public unrest which if it was not handled diplomatically it would have led to blood shed which he blames Tupua as the instigator.

Incidentally, the Prime Minister noted that now

that the Off-Shore Center has evolved into the Samoa International Finance Authority, (SIFA) which is a legitimate government entity, Tuilaepa that the same Tupua has returned with defamatory allegations of money laundry against SIFA.

"I am convinced that Tui Atua has a selective memory," added the Prime Minister. "He appears

to remember things which he wants to remember only."

In conclusion, Tui Atua's continued denial of his short comings, says Tuilaepa is a sign of a person who should not be trusted.

for three years (monotaga) to be eligible to participate in general elections.

"This amendment was deliberately included to personify our respect to our resident matais serving their respective villages and constituency day in and day out.

"The greatest insult of all time to our resident Samoan matais is for a candidate who has never provided service or contributed a sene to the village and for thw electoral developments and welfare to pop up from nowhere and claim his right as an election candidate.

"Is he (Tui Atua) really willing to take that gamble and insult our resident serving matais?

"Is he (Tui Atua) prioritizing the rights of Samoans overseas over our residents who are toiling daily to ensure our survival and our people's daily needs are met?

"To my political opposites, I say this again, Ole ala ile pule ole Tautua. (The way to Leadership is through Service).

On that note, the Prime Minister says that he will not set any precedent when it comes to absentee voting.

"The same issue was presented to past Prime Ministers and they remain firm.

"And who am I a meager servant of the people to change that."

Tuilaepa is also aware that the Tuiatua is "inciting false hope by provoking the emotions of the voters" using private remittances as an argument to introduce absentee voting.

"It's no secret that private remittances play a pivotal role in the development of our country.

"But Tupua suddenly forgets or oblivious to the fact the remittances are a direct cash injection to families and relatives here," said Tuilaepa.

"And the truth of the matter is our families here are reaping the fruits of their overseas relatives' hard labour from their private remittances and we acknowledge their valuable contribution.."

"Remittances is the life line for families and used for their faalavelaves, to build new homes, buy cars, pay for their day to day necessities and even pay for their children's education.

"And government is more than appreciative of that fact.

"For Tui Atua to play with the emotions of voters is a conniving ploy, one of his well known political tactic.

"For the record," concluded the Prime Minister. "Your government is not restraining any Samoan from voting or running in general elections.

"That is the constitutional right of Samoans that cannot and is not taken for granted by my administration."
